- Allow 2 hours to complete the training, or save your work as you go.
- When training is completed, you will be routed to a consent form that you must submit in order to complete your background check for yourself through the NCS Risk website.
- You will receive an email from Sterling Volunteers telling you what to do next to FINISH.

Church Music Notes

Songs of Praise

The song *Glorious Day (Living He Loved Me)* originated with the contemporary Christian band Casting Crowns. The lyrics came from the John Wilbur Chapman hymn "One Day When Heaven Was Filled With His Praises" or more often called "One Day" which was written in 1909. The modern version of the song was written by worship pastor Michael Bleecker.

He tells the story of needing a triumphant song to be sung to commemorate the Resurrection of Jesus. He says, "I walked over to my stack of hymnals and pulled out the 1939 copy of 'The Hymns of Praise' from a church in Kenosha, Wisconsin." As he flipped through the yellowed pages he found the song "One Day." He read the words of the refrain: "Living, He loved me; dying He saved me; Buried, He carried my sins far away; Rising, He justified freely forever; One day He's coming - oh glorious day!"

He concludes, "That's the gospel in four creatively written lines. The verses of the song expound each line of the chorus: verse one



describes the birth of Christ, verse two the death of Christ, verse three the ascension of Christ and verse four the return of Christ. I'm grateful for the Presbyterian evangelist John Wilbur

Chapman and his hymn from the late 1800s. From combining his words with a melody the Lord gave me in five minutes, came "Glorious Day." I pray that it be used to teach the gospel and stir the affections of others for Jesus Christ."

Our last Praise song today is No. 341, **To God Be the Glory.** This beloved gospel hymn was written by Fanny Crosby, of whom it was once descriptively said, "she is a blind lady whose heart can see splendidly in the sunshine of God's love." She herself said, "Darkness may throw a shadow over my outer vision, but there is no cloud that can keep the sunlight of hope from a trustful soul."



The words of this hymn bring to mind Revelation 5:12, 13: "In a loud voice they sang: 'Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!' Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: 'To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!" Written in 1875, this hymn was introduced in England by evangelists Ira Sankey and Dwight Moody. It was immediately popular in England, but almost unknown in America until rediscovered by Billy Graham during his 1952 British crusade. It has since rightfully become as popular in America as in England.
